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Murfreesboro Historical Association Wins Gold For Web Site Design

The Murfreesboro Historical Association has been awarded a **2008 GOLD MarCom Award** for Overall Web Site Design in the Non-Profit / Pro-Bono category. Preserving and interpreting the architectural and cultural heritage of the Town of Murfreesboro, North Carolina, the Association's holdings include ten historic buildings, three museums and two cemeteries.

MarCom is an international awards competition that recognizes outstanding creative achievement by marketing and communication professionals. There were over 5,000 entries from throughout the United States and several foreign countries in the 2008 competition. Winners were selected in media and communication efforts including marketing, publications, marketing/promotion, public service, creativity and electronic/interactive.

The site was designed by Anne Beekman, a former Professor of graphic design at Chowan University, who donated her services. Professor Beekman has since relocated to her native Ohio. The Murfreesboro Historical Association's site is online at www.murfreesboronc.org.

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
